

Minutes of Seniors AGM 25th March 2014

1. Apologies were received from **Peter Smith, Trevor Hansson, Robert Nicholls, Peter Rockett, Jim Elkins, Frank Willsher and Ron Duce.**
2. The minutes of the 2013 AGM were approved and there were no matters arising.

5. **Patrick Rooney** was elected as captain, **Mike Atkins** as vice-captain and **Steve Davis, Ed Carpenter, Bill Taunton and Barry Muir** as committee members.
6. Patrick Rooney thanked Steve for his achievements during the year.
7. **Proposals (Attached)**
 - a) From December to February inclusive all senior roll ups will start at 9.00am. Last year's AGM stipulated November to February. In November this meant we could not have two tee starts, hence the proposed change. - **The proposal was approved.**
 - b) The committee should aim for 24 qualifiers a year. This is all seniors' qualifiers including silverware competitions. - **The proposal was approved.**
 - a) Some roll up days, designated as non-qualifiers can be made qualifiers on the day. **The proposal was rejected.**
 - b) When there is a club midweek comp there will also be a seniors non qualifying roll up. **This is what is already being done and it was confirmed.**
 - c) Minimum of two roll ups per month to be team competitions. Last year's AGM passed a resolution saying a maximum of three team competitions. **This new proposal was passed.**
 - d) Maximum of one roll up per month to be a fun competition - **The proposal was rejected.**
 - e) One roll up match play singles or better ball per month with the prize money to winners by biggest margin after 18 holes. **The proposal was rejected. However it was generally felt that we should try and organise more match play events.**
 - f) Seniors should have a Champion of Champions competition. Chris T. and David S. to put together a paper for the committee to consider on how to run this comp. -**The proposal was passed. The committee need to decide on the qualifying competitions and David Scott agreed to run the competition.**

AOB

There was a proposal that we should have a nearest the pin competition for all comps. This was not seconded but it was generally felt we should have nearest the pin more often.

Patrick said that Ken had agreed that when we are restricted to one tee we should, in consultation with the pro shop on the day, try and get some groups off early and also some starting on the 14th tee.
