

**STUDLEY WOOD SENIORS GOLF
DAYTONA TEAM GAME**

- a. Teams of 3 only.
- b. Stableford Scoring Format with Full Handicap allowance. Highest team score wins the competition.
- c. Non Qualifier off White Tees.
- d. Using the Player A, B and C sections of the scorecard, on each hole the total scoring is as follows:
 - a. Each player's score potentially counts towards the total with the highest score in the team shown first in the team total column, and other scores then recorded in descending order **but** only a player's score of 1 or more Stableford points counts towards that total.
 - b. Range of examples in Stableford points;
 - If player A scores 2, player B scores 3, and the player C scores 1, the team score for that hole is **"321"**.
 - If player A scores 2, player B also scores 2 and player C scores 1, the team score for the hole is **"221"**.
 - If player A scores 2, player B also scores 2 but player C fails to score any Stableford points then the team score is **NOT** 220, but is just **"22"**.
 - If player A scores 3, but players B and C both fail to score then the team score is just **"3"** points
 - c. Team scores for each hole are added up at the end with the highest team score winning the game.

Note: It will be apparent that the most successful team will be the team where all the players consistently make a score, even 1 point, as a "blob" will result in a score for the team in the "tens" but if all 3 players gain points a score in the "hundreds" will result.

Please take care with the clarity of your scorecard recording as this will be important for those responsible for checking the cards.
