

## **Rules of Seniors' Silverware competitions**

To be eligible to play in seniors' silverware competitions all competitors must have a competition playing handicap, and played at least 3 qualifying rounds in seniors' organised roll up games off the **white tees** in the previous 12 months.

Note this requirement does not apply to the seniors' club championship which is run by the **club** and the only entry requirement is to be over 55 years of age with a competition playing handicap.

All matches must be played on normal greens (not temporary greens). In the event that adverse ground conditions results in the use of temporary greens then these competitions will be postponed to the next suitable date when full greens are back in play.

All seniors' silverware competitions are qualifiers and all players must sign in to the computer before starting their round and enter their score on the computer at the end of the round. Details to be entered on the card include, name of competition entered, date, player's name (under player A), tee used, and playing handicap (whole number). All cards must be properly and accurately completed and signed by the player and marker.

For seniors organised competitions after entering scores on the computer cards must be handed in to the seniors' roll up organiser.

For the club organised seniors competition cards after entering scores on the computer cards must be placed in the competition box (there is no roll up)

### **Seniors Committee Silverware Competitions:**

Annual Challenge: Medal off white tees, full handicap.

Quarterly Challenge: Medal off white tees, full handicap.

Memorial Trophy: Medal off white tees, full handicap.

Jeremy Potter Memorial Trophy: Stableford off white tees, full handicap.

Roy Holland Memorial Trophy: Stableford off white tees, full handicap.

### **Seniors Club Competition:**

Senior's Club Championship: Medal off white tees and played over 2 rounds, full handicap. There will be a best gross score winner, a best handicap score winner and a best over 70 years of age gross score winner.
