	Subject/Discussion Points	Action
1.	Minutes —the previous minutes of the 6 th September meeting were agreed. These had been posted on the Seniors webpage.	
2.	Feedback from General/Mens Committee meeting—Agreement has been made to replace nets and accompanying cladding. Mens Midweek Medals will cease in November but the mens midweek Stableford will continue and be supported by the Seniors. No progress made in distributing 22 loyalty vouchers.	
3.	Treasurers Report-the report is attached and the year to date surplus shows £1078.13. However prizes will be required to be paid out for the Yorkshire Tour, Singles Knock Out, Pairs Knock out and Winter League. £120 has been received for tickets to the Champagne Tasting evening however this event needs further support to be viable. 7.	Pairs Knock Out – this was won by Paul Dore and Kingi Sharma. Payment for prizes will be made onto members cards. GP will credit the Club £170 in order that Paul Fitzgerald will make the payout to the winners.	





8.	Winter League – 44 members are so far participating with 10 payments outstanding at this time. GP to contact MW and Trevor Hansson for assistance on the spreadsheet as he will now run it. The league will start on 20 th October.

Year to Date Position

Our bank balance as of 2nd October 2022 stands at £2,026.79.

Attached is the year-to-date P&L, showing the current 2022 financial situation.

The balance shows a current surplus of £1,078.13 but includes the following:

- 1. Income from the Singles (£195), Pairs Knock Out (£190) and Winter League (£115 currently) competitions, against which there will be prizes to be paid out;
- 2. Prizes for the Yorkshire Tour
- 3. Refunds due to:

Tony Beedell (£67 for Tewkesbury and £60 deposit for Yorkshire tour). I have emailed Tony twice seeking to repay him but have not received a reply;

Ben Pritchard £60 deposit for Yorkshire tour from which Ben has withdrawn.

4. £120 in ticket sales for Terry's Champagne tasting night, the proceeds of which are for the captain's charity. This needs further support to be viable?

Adjusting for the above gives a surplus thus far this year of around £180.

Yorkshire Tour

Income of £6,884 (allowing for repayment of Pritchard / Beedell deposits). Expenditure to WRGB ltd of £6,740. I am allowing for a spend of £141 on prizes, which should give us £155 of AB Golf Vouchers – all subject to confirmation by Jonathan and AB Golf.

M4 Winter League

The bank transfer payment to M4 for Affiliation (£10) and 2022/23 Membership (£40) has been set up and will be authorised by Martin.

Trophy Engraving
