Format

This is an 18 hole match play singles competition.

Eligibility

Open to all Studley Wood Seniors.

Handicap Allowance

Matches will be played from the silver tees using the match play index. The playing handicap will be 100% of the course handicap. After playing handicaps have been calculated, the player with the lowest handicap will play off zero strokes and the other player will receive strokes determined by the difference between the two playing handicaps.

Competition Rules

The timetable for the completion of rounds is as follows:

Round 1 - 30 May

Round 2 - 25 June

Round 3 - 23 July

Round 4 - 27 August

Round 5 - 17 September

Round 6 -17 October

The "Administrator" will conduct a random draw (without any weightings) to determine the first round ties. These ties will be held on Tuesday 23 May. If a player is unable to play their match on that date they may arrange a suitable alternative date with their opponent. All first round matches must be completed by 30 May.

Both parties will use their best efforts to meet the deadlines set. In exceptional circumstances the Seniors' Captain may extend the deadline.

Each match will conclude on the eighteenth hole of play and the margin of the win will be recorded e.g. 1 up, 2 up etc. If the match is tied after 18 holes, play will continue from the 1st tee on a sudden death basis until a winner is decided.

The result from each match shall be reported to the "administrator". The Seniors' Captain will keep all seniors' informed of progress in the competition.

The winner of the competition will be entered in the Seniors' Champion of Champions competition.
