We have secured a superb tour based on the Vale Hotel Golf and Spa Resort. We will play at:

Vale Resort - The Lake Course: The Lake Course is now nearing its 25th anniversary and continues to demand the full attention of thousands of golfers each year. At 6,436 yards, it certainly packs a punch. From the off, this par-72 course makes clear it's not for the faint-hearted, with an opening par-three shot in full view of the hotel! Survive that and there's the sizable challenge that accompanies 12 of the championship golf course's 18 holes involving water.



Vale Resort - The Wales National Course: There are several reasons the Wales National Course should be on your radar. For starters, it's a par-73 course — a relative rarity in terms of golfing architecture. At 7,433 yards from the championship tees, it is one of the longest golf courses outside the United States. (A more modest and Seniors friendly 5986 yards off the yellow tees.) Another major draw is its setting. Picture mature woodland, wide and narrow fairways, and vast water and bunker features, that are teaming with wildlife.



The Rolls of Monmouth Golf Club: A must play on any Wales golf break; The Rolls of Monmouth Golf Club is the former home of Charles Stewart Rolls the early aviator and motoring pioneer and now a Rolls Royce of golf! That other sleek driving machine, Greg Norman, also paused here on his way to the top of world golf. He was attached to The Rolls of Monmouth as Touring Professional in the 1980's. Tony Jacklin often wondered why this majestic course remained a well-kept secret. Astonishingly it is still relatively unknown outside of Wales.
