- a) The winner of the Champion of Champions cup be automatically included in the following years final.
This was accepted.
- b) The number of Senior run Qualifiers to be played in a year to be reduced to 16 from 24, this to include any Senior run Silverware matches.
This was accepted.
- c) All Silverware competitions to be played off main greens not temporary ones.
This was accepted.
- d) Entry to Senior competitions after the official sign up date should not be permitted.
This was accepted.

- e) The Winter League matches to be included in the number of qualifying rounds each year.
